1. A Medical grant will only be considered for conditions that need in-wards and treatments (for surgical and medical cases). They can be for:
    - a. Heart illness/Surgery such as Heart attack, By pass, Valve repair, 2D Eco, NGO, Eco, Ex. ECG. Pace walker (In plant battle) (Up to Rs.50,000/- per year effective with the date on the bill and the same should submit within 03 months' time. (This will be not considered the Government or Privet treatments and no discrimination)
    - b. Major Surgery or sickness such as cancer surgeries, Liver, Kidneys, Lungs, Bowels, Nephrectomy, Neuro surgeries, Radiotherapy, Physiotherapy. Permanent injury (Up to Rs.40,000/-)
      - i. If a beneficiary suffers from any loss mentioned below due to an accident the committee of SSWF may approve to provide financial assistance to the said beneficiary/rise as hereinafter specified. Provided however if such injuries cause multiple losses the payment will be made only for one loss for which the highest amount is payable subject to the terms, conditions and exclusions mentioned in this document.
      - ii. The total claims made by a beneficiary at various stages shall not exceed 100% of the particular benefit.
      - iii. Payments are made under this scheme only after permanent disability is confirmed by a Consultant with Board Certification in the relevant field of specialty and period of three(03) months has been elapsed from the date of occurring the injury. (In case of inability to obtain the opinion from Consultant Neurologist, submit a report for the above purpose)

- c. Minor surgery – Under local anesthesia (Up to Rs.30,000/-), Any minor surgery.
  - d. Medical treatments needing in-wards patients will be considered on case by case, basis on serosity. (will be decided by the Board of Trustees on case by case – Up to Rs.15,000/-).
  - e. Expenses on special investigations e.g; CT scanning, MRI scanning, Dialysis. The following special investigations will be done for non GVS members who retired before 01<sup>st</sup> May 2012. Endoscopy, ECG and Colonoscopy (Up to Rs.20,000/-)
  - f. PHACOA + IOL – Cataract (Up to Rs.8,000/-)
2. Drug bills and the claims requested for LAB investigations will not be considered unless they are in-wards during that period. Drug bills will be considered for payments only during the in-wards period when those drugs are not available in the hospitals.
  3. however, there is no provision to consider payment for medical bills.
  4. Repeated drug bills payment – Patients who need continues treatments shall claim these drugs from nearest SLAF medical Centers.
  5. Decision of the Board of Trustees is final in all matters.
  6. All claims shall be submitted within 03 months from the occurrence.
  7. Members will be eligible to claim medical grants only after 03 months since the date they got their SSWF membership.
