

• School Items: Contributions in the form of School Bags, Pens, Pencils, Erasers, Shoes, Lunch Boxes, Water Bottles, School Sports items, Maps, Mathematical Instrument Boxes, and other related items.

• Financial Assistance: Monetary support to address the diverse needs of the children.
