

FLIGHT SAFETY POSTER COMPETITION – 2024

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE FLIGHT SAFETY POSTER COMPETITION

Theme

An appropriate Flight / Ground safety theme such as Crew Resource Management, Passengers/Cargo handling, Fire and rescue, Alcohol / Self-medication, Elementary stresses, Corrosion, Disorientation, Stress and fatigue etc; which are common in day-today flying environment or a message illustrated with a caption should present as an art work.

Drawing medium

A **standard size white colour Bristol board** using any medium of colouring scheme such as Pastel, Water/Tube colours, Poster paint, Colour pencils or platignum. A combination of these mediums are also acceptable.

Authentication / Validation

The Chairman/Director of the aviation entity / Principal of the school should authenticate the drawing is an original idea of the particular person/student and it has not been obtained from any other source. A rubber stamp must be placed with the signature.

The following details are to be written on the reverse side of the poster

- a. Name with Initials (as per the NIC / Postal ID)
- b. Aviation entity's address / Class and School with address

- c. Contact numbers
- d. NIC / Postal ID No. (A copy should attach)

Selection

The selection of the winners will be done by a qualified panel of judges under the following criteria.

- a. Prizes – Aviation entities

The winners of the competition will receive the following categories.

First, Second and Third place winners – gifts & certificates

10 consolation winners - certificates

- b. Prizes – Schools

The winners of the competition will receive the following categories.

Theme

Submissions

Any self-written article related to aviation, appropriate humour, cartoons or appropriate extracts from other journals or research articles with proper approval from the original author(s).

Authentication / Validation

The Chairman/Director of the aviation entity / Principal of the school should authenticate the submission is an original idea of the particular person/student and if its an extract, the proper approval from the original author(s) to be available. A rubber stamp must be placed with the signature.

The following details are to be included with the article

- a. Name with Initials (as per the NIC / Postal ID)
- b. Aviation entity's address / Class and School with address

- c. Contact numbers
- d. A copy of the NIC / Postal ID
- e. Approval from the original author(s) for extracts

Selection

The selection of the winners will be done by a qualified panel of judges

- a. Prizes – Aviation entities

The winners of the best 03 articles will receive certificates

- b. Prizes – Schools

The winners of the best 03 articles will receive certificates.

Entries and date of submission

Any number of articles can be submitted by a single candidate, however, **only one article will be selected for above prizes and publishing.**
